



PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Posters

The standard size for posters is 120 cm wide and 90 cm height. The format is not established, but the poster is to be written in a font big enough to be read in a one meter distance from it (minimum type font size: 32). The Scientific Committee suggests the traditional standard for presentation (introduction, objectives, methods, results, conclusions and a few references). The main text should be preceded by title with a bigger type font, authors and affiliations involved. The inclusion of tables, figures, photos and graphics facilitates the understanding of the results.

The setting of the poster must be done by one of the authors on **Monday, October 5th** in the morning. It should be exposed during the Symposium (there is enough space in Minascentro). One of the authors should be present near the poster to answer questions, suggestions, etc, in the period between **1:30pm and 2:00pm on Monday (October 5th) or Tuesday (October 6th)**. The Organizing Committee will send the schedule to be followed.

Oral presentation

The authors of the papers approved for oral presentation by the Scientific Committee will be able to use traditional audiovisual resources (PowerPoint) or other less common. The Organizing Committee must be aware of what kind of equipment or software is needed for adequate oral presentation. The maximum time spent during the presentation will strictly be 10 minutes, followed by 5 minutes of discussion.

Other information

1. **Registration of at least one of the authors** on the 5th Brazilian Symposium for Sickle Cell Disease and other Hemoglobinopathies is obligatory.
2. A **maximum of 3 papers per author/participant** registered on the event will be allowed.
3. Papers which have already been accepted by the scientific committee will be published in Annals. Full papers which have received prize will be announced during the event.
